


Canvas Course Storage: 500MB

<p>FILES</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Files uploaded into the Course Files area (e.g. images, documents, videos etc.) <p>Note: If students are allowed to create discussions (i.e. non-graded), any files attached to student-created discussions count against course quotas.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Copied Files - If you copy files from one course to another course via course import, the storage quota for the new course will not be affected. Graded Assignment Submissions or attachments added to graded discussion replies. Max upload size per file for assignments with submission type 'online/file uploads' is 5GB*. Alternative submission options such as URL upload are available. Graded submissions through the Canvas Turnitin integration. Max upload size per file is 40MB and a max page count of 400. <p>*Uploads larger than 500MB for submission files are not recommended as some networks may time out during upload.</p>
<p>VIDEOS</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Videos uploaded into the Course Files area, as above. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Videos uploaded or recorded (e.g. with webcam) using the 'record/upload media' tool in Canvas. This includes the following areas: Assignments, Conversations, Rich Content Editor and Speedgrader. Max upload size per video is 500MB. <p>Note: Videos uploaded or recorded using the 'record/upload media' tool cannot be accessed for re-use in another area or retrieved once deleted from the page/area they were created in.</p> <p>Canvas integrates with Mediasite which is recommended to host large media and audio files.</p>
