



# PREPARING FOR A RESPONDUS LDB EXAM

## OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES SUMMARY

FOLLOW THESE STEPS TO ENSURE YOU  
ARE FULLY PREPARED TO ADMINISTER  
YOUR CANVAS/RESPONDUS LOCKDOWN  
BROWSER (LDB) EXAM

### STEP 1

Review the complete list of [Operational Guidelines](#) to familiarise yourself with the full process and responsibilities.

### STEP 2

Agree any changes to your assessment, if required, with Academic Affairs.

### STEP 3

Contact the Exams Office for guidance on possible exam locations, dates and times.

### STEP 4

Submit a request to the DLSSS team for the Respondus tool to be enabled in your course: [Respondus LDB request form](#).

### STEP 5

Receive training materials from the VLE Pedagogy Support team. If needed, [arrange a consultation](#) to discuss relevant approaches to assessment.

### STEP 6

Create your exam questions in a Canvas 'Question Bank'. Have these reviewed by an External Examiner.

### STEP 7

Set-up your Canvas quiz and apply the Respondus LDB settings using the advice in [this staff guide](#).

### STEP 8

Give your students an ungraded Respondus LDB quiz prior to the real exam to ensure all settings are correct. Introduce [this student guide](#) to students.

### STEP 9

Contact Information Services one week before the exam to request that the computers and hardware are checked.

### STEP 10

Your exam can now take place on Canvas using Respondus LockDown Browser.
